### Summary

This is summary for

- DoC regulation only but not for CoC one,
- DoC registered by local representative itself with federal service directly (CB not involved).

If you need to know CoC requirements or DoC registered by accredited CB in this case you could ask your CB that manages your orders.

There are 4 regulations that regulate the usage of GTIN and GLN codes in EAC and GOST DoC (declaration) procedures. The cross-regulation is very complicated and, moreover, some documents contradict others. But all of them are enforced and valid that's why applicants and manufacturers should follow their requirements.

We have tried to show all requirements clear as possible. Sorry, if something not clear enough yet. Have a look at the tables below to get details.
